The Members Exhibition at Fuller Craft Museum, a tradition dating back to the 70s, is a biennial event that features work ranging from turned wood and digital photography to wood-fired stoneware and oil on canvas. This exhibition includes a wide-variety of media to represent the talented artists who comprise Fuller Craft's nationwide membership.
