Robot rock star band Flooky & the Beans incorporate linguistic, logical, musical, bodily, spatial, interpersonal, intrapersonal and naturalist learning concepts into their performances to provide rich learning experience that children can relate to in their own unique way. Flooky & the Beans interactive performances encourage children and caregivers to exercise, socialize, use their imaginations, foster their personalities and enjoy having fun and spending time together. Show times are at 1:00 p.m., 2:15 p.m., and 3:30 p.m.

Families can also participate in ongoing demonstrations, metal-themed workshops and art activities throughout the day. Visitors can practice metal tooling with colored pencils, learn to create metal effects with polymer clay or try a hand at letter stamping into metal. Visit the galleries to see how artists Jamie Bennett and James Reynolds use metal to make art. Docents will be on hand to talk to parents and children about the artwork currently on exhibit.
